

**SPECIAL EVENT

Unless you have SPECIFICALLY stated in your application to the contrary and provided substantive detail on alternative measures in place, YOU MUST ENSURE:-

- A valid Event Network Booking is in place and MUST accurately reflect the Order and it's duration,
- Pedestrian access and access to frontages is maintained at all times
- Emergency service access to properties within the restricted area is maintained at all times and through the area unless you have stated to the contrary on application
- Reasonable steps are taken to advise the public on the reason and duration of the restriction
- Notification to Network Rail (as provided by NRSWA 1991) where a restriction may affect the safe working of a level crossing
- Notification to Highways England where a restriction may affect the flow of traffic on a motorway or trunk road (especially slip roads access/exit) Tel. 0300 123 5000

**Special Conditions (where prescribed):**

We trust that you will ensure safe working practices at all times for your operatives, workforce, event participants and the public and that you will only apply the restriction that will cause delay only for as long as necessary and you will do all you can to ensure prompt removal of the restriction when safe and appropriate to do so.
